



COMMUNITY NAMING & UNDERWRITING OPPORTUNITIES



\$1,000,000

EVENTS HALL

Beautifully appointed former chapel with 2-story ceiling and a balcony. This hall can seat more than 200 for afterschool programming, professional development and family seminars, and the space is available for rent by outside groups.

\$500,000

THE THEATER

An 800-seat theater in our historic Lake Avenue school building. The Theater is used by our partner schools and programs for activities including graduations, award ceremonies, school assemblies, and musicals.

\$100,000

LEARNING CENTERS (2)

Large, updated flex spaces for our programs and partners to use for programming. Students complete homework, access computer and internet resources, and receive support from family members and program staff.

\$50,000

THE CAFETORIUM

Not only a place where students eat lunch and share family dinners, the Cafetorium on Summers Parker Campus (Hoover Drive) was recently renovated to include a small stage for school gatherings and performing arts events.

\$25,000

GYMNASIUM

This large, modern gym hosts daily physical education and health classes, sports games, pep rallies, and school wide family events for students attending school on our Summers Parker Campus (Hoover Drive).

\$15,000

CONFERENCE ROOMS (2)

Our conference rooms host board and committee meetings and are used by staff and community members on a regular basis. Locations include the Foundation House (4 Lake View Park) and EnCompass (16 Lake View Park)

\$5,000

FAMILY NIGHTS (12)

Our Family Nights occur throughout the year at different program sites. Activities include learning showcases, parent workshops, cooking demonstrations, and more. These events create connections as families get to know each other and celebrate learning together.

\$5,000

COMMUNITY KITCHEN STATIONS (7)

Our new Community Kitchen will provide hands on education about nutrition and holistic good health to children and their families. The kitchen includes 7 complete work stations.

\$2,500

BACKPACK PROGRAMS (4)

Provide weekly backpacks of emergency food for 25 children in need for the whole school year -OR- send 250 students back-to-school with the supplies they need to succeed.

\$2,000

CLASSROOMS (30)

Classrooms within our school buildings are the settings for learning and growth for students in kindergarten through grade 12. Locations include Lake Avenue, Hoover Drive, and The Norman Howard School.
