EnCompass Afterschool, Summer Learning, and Daytime Intervention programs promote academic achievement and social-emotional development for elementary students, and help school and organization partners address their strategic priorities.

PROGRAMS

Afterschool Learning

Our academically-based after-school programs use learning as a platform for social-emotional development and personal growth. STEM-based inquiry, hands-on learning, enrichment clubs, and language/literacy support combine for a holistic, safe, supportive setting. 95-120 additional learning hours per student.

Summer Learning

We provide summer learning programs for more than 350 students at sites throughout Rochester. Comprehensive, full-day programming infused with inquiry, language/literacy support, and STEM create positive experiences, community connections, and prevent achievement gaps caused by summer learning loss. 4-6 week programs for 10-160 students.

Daytime Intervention

Speech-Language Pathologists provide integrated support within classrooms and pull-out services for identified students to address language challenges.

Academic Coaches partner with classroom teachers to provide small group reading intervention services.
