Daytime Intervention

An EnCompass Academic Coach is paired with classroom teacher and pushes into classrooms to support learning and works with an identified caseload of students to review concepts and promote executive functioning skills. 15-20 students per AC.

Compressed Credit Recovery

Based on our successful Quest program developed in conjunction with the University of Rochester at East High School, this unique model can be tailored to meet school needs. Dedicated Site Coordinator collaborates with school staff to provide intensive academic and social-emotional support to help students recover credits and prepare to graduate. Up to 75 students.

Reaents Prep



Regents prep is often done in small groups or one-on-one during school or after school and targets youth's individual needs to effectively pass the identified Regents exam. 12-15 students per AC.
