REINVESTING IN YOUTH WORKS!

RIY is an educationally enhanced community program that creates stability for atrisk youth by helping them build positive relationships, academic successes, and healthy engagement with their families, schools, and communities.

HOW IT WORKS

Who?

Youth ages 11-17 who are at risk of involvement with juvenile justice or child and family services systems; most live within the Rochester City School District, and are referred by FACT, probation officers, or school personnel.

How long?

6-8 months of holistic programming, with strong aftercare and community connection support. Summer learning program is available.

How do you evaluate and share progress?

Weekly team meetings and assessment at regular intervals drive individualized planning; progress is shared twice monthly with involved professionals.

WHY IT WORKS

Every day involves a connection— an encouraging text to get to class on time, a check-in at school, vocational planning in the community. As many as 3 touch-points per day. Youth have a dedicated Core Team, who focus from day one on personalized supports and asset-building to phase out "professional" supports and integrate natural family and community supports.

Each youth and family guide their own plan to build self- efficacy, develop skills, engage in school and their community, nurture relationships that support healthy behaviors, and access support.

Caring, professional staff are credentialed in their field, trained in trauma-informed care, utilize strength-based approaches, standardized measures, and best practices.
